4 DAY SAFARI

or the four-day safari we will make the long trek through the crown jewel of safari parks: the Serengeti. We will spend three of the four days travel to, through, and back from the Serengeti. Along the way, you'll be able to see herds of all types of animals. There will be gazelles, impalas, giraffes, elephants, and wildebeest. In the trees, leopards will be dining on their prey. Hyena, lions, and vultures will battle over a meal of gazelles and the water will be filled with deadly predators like crocodiles and hippos.

On the final day, we will get up early to descend the stunning Ngorongoro Crater Conservation Area. It is a 2,000 foot deep, 11 miles across, extinct volcanic crater that is home to the same animals as the Serengeti, with the exception, the Rhino which is extinct on the Serengeti plains. You'll spend the day being entertained by the mating ostrich, stalking hippos, and lazy lions.

DAY 1

The driver will pick you up early to begin the long drive to the Serengeti National Park. Along the way, you can stop for snacks and souvenirs. You'll see much of the Tanzanian countryside as you traverse the Maasi regions of the country. You'll see the men and boys as young as five, tending to their herds. For a dollar, you can take their picture. You may even see the Black Maasai, the boys that have undergone the ritual to become a man.

In the afternoon, you'll begin your game drive across the magnificent Serengeti National Park plains. The word 'Serengeti' means 'endless plains', which describes the park's massive 5,600 square miles. Even though it is quite large, the game drive does not disappoint. The driver will be on the radio to find out where all the animals are active. The Serengeti is arguably the best safari park in the world and has vast herds of wildebeest, zebras, gazelles, and giraffes. Every year these herds made up of millions of animals migrate from the central Serengeti to Kenya's Masai Mara and back again creating an incredible spectacle. Along with herd animals, elephants, giraffes, lions, leopards, cheetah, hyenas, hippos, and jackals are readily visible. At 5 PM, when the park closes, you'll be driven to your tented camp for dinner and to sleep.

4 DAY SAFARI





You'll start early to do a day-long game drive across the Serengeti. The driver will take you to all of the active spots like waterholes. If the Great Migration is there during your safari, you'll see the massive herd moving slowly to their next destination.

You'll continue the game drive until the driver takes you back to your tented camp for the night.

DAY 3

After breakfast, we conclude your Serengeti game drive with an encore drive back through the park en route to the Ngorongoro Crater Conservation Area. You'll stay in your tented camp for the night.

DAY 4

The day starts early to see the animals when they are the most active—in the morning—as you descend the Crater. You'll spend several hours there before heading back to Arusha.

With prior arrangements, we can drop you off at Kilimanjaro International Airport (JRO) after the safari or book additional lodging.

Note: Clients can make any flight departing after 8:00 PM from Kilimanjaro International Airport (JRO)
