5 DAY SAFARI

or the five-day safari, we will take you to the expansive Tarangire National Park which is known for its large herds of elephants. If you are lucky, you may also spot the elusive treeclimbing lions. On day two you'll visit Lake Manyara National Park—a wonderland of birds. On day three you'll make the long trek through the crown jewel of safari parks: the Serengeti. Along the way, you'll be able to see herds of all types of animals, gazelles, impalas, giraffes, elephants, and wildebeest. In the trees, leopards will be dining on their prey. Hyena, lions, and vultures battle over a meal of gazelles, and the water is filled with deadly predators like crocodiles and hippos. On day four, you'll do an encore game drive back through the Serengeti as you make your way toward the Ngorongoro Crater Conservation Area. On day five you'll descend the Crater. It is an 11 miles across, 2,000 foot deep, extinct volcanic that is home to all the same animals as the Serengeti, with the exception, the Rhino which is extinct on the Serengeti plains. You'll spend the day being entertained by the mating ostrich, stalking hippos, and lazy lions.

DAY 1

Our safari driver will pick you up from your lodge after breakfast. It is a few-hour drive to Tarangire National Park, the sixth-largest national park in Tanzania. It is known for its large herd of elephants and massive baobab trees. You'll be entertained by herds of wildebeest, zebras, and impalas as you weave your way back and forth across the Tarangire River. Your game drive will last until 5 PM when the park closes. Afterward, you'll be driven to your tented camp in time for dinner.

DAY 2

Your drive is a few hours to Lake Manyara National Park. Although small in size, this park is one of the most diverse animals preserve in the country. The lake covers more than two-thirds of the park. It falls in the shadow of the end of the East Arm of the Great Rift Valley. The Rift Valley has been a rich source of hominid fossils. The famed "Lucy" skeleton was discovered there. Your game drive begins in the dense forests with monkeys, elephants, and baboons surrounding your vehicle. You'll continue across the grasslands as giraffes, wildebeest, and zebra graze alongside each other. Additionally, the park is home to more than 350 species of bird such as flamingos, pelicans, and storks.

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DAY 3

We will drive from your lodge to the magnificent Serengeti National Park. The word 'Serengeti' means 'endless plains', which describes the park's massive 5,600 square miles. Even though it is quite large, the game drive does not disappoint. The driver will be on the radio to find out where all the animals are active. The Serengeti is arguably the best safari park in the world and has vast herds of wildebeest, zebras, gazelles, and giraffes. Every year these herds made up of millions of animals migrate from the central Serengeti to Kenya's Masai Mara and back again creating an incredible spectacle. Along with herd animals, elephants, giraffes, lions, leopards, cheetah, hyenas, hippos, and jackals are readily visible. After a long day of animal viewing, we will return you to your tented camp for the night.

DAY 4

You'll embark on an encore game drive spending as much time as you like viewing all the wildlife the Serengeti has to offer. You'll make your way back across the plains to your tented camp inside the Ngorongoro Crater Conservation Area.

DAY 5

After breakfast, you'll conclude your safari with a game drive through the magical Ngorongoro Crater before heading back to your hotel. With prior arrangements, our guide can take you straight to Kilimanjaro International Airport (JRO).
